Lent is meant to be a time when we seek to be closer to God; to seek God's face as we have read multiple times in the Psalms we studied this year. Lent is a time to remove items that are keeping **US** from being closer to God. Is your schedule so full you cannot set aside time to pray, to be in a quiet conversation with God? If so, you need to find that item or items getting in the way, and give them up.
